Tiansai Skyline of Gobi Marselan Selection, Xinjiang, China, 2018

Founded by Chen Lizhong in 2010, Tiansai Vineyard is one of the first vineyards to be certified organic. It also has one of China's foremost wine experts, Li Demei, as its consulting winemaker. With a leafy, gamey nose and hints of red fruits, it opens on the palate to offer fresh blackcurrants, juicy red cherries and herbs, soft, earthy tannins, and an attractive long finish.



Grace Vineyard Deep Blue, Shanxi / Ningxia, China, 2020

The name "Deep Blue" was inspired by the book "Blue Ocean Strategy" which symbolises the pioneering and enterprising spirit of Grace Vineyard, helmed by Judy Chan since 2002. With aromas of ripe dark plums, cassis and blue fruits on the nose, and a generous palate of juicy ripe dark fruits, notes of dark chocolate and silky tannins, you'll enjoy a well-integrated wine with a long finish.



The Starting Point Riesling, Ningxia, China, 2021

This small artisanal winery, helmed by Reisa Jiang, is committed to low intervention and sustainability and produces less than 10,000 bottles a year, with the oldest vines in the region planted in the 1990s. Aromas of zesty orange, melon, bananas, white flowers and honey, followed by crispy acidity and chalky minerals on the palate, offer a lively, vibrant finish.
