FIRST CLASS



Krug Grande Cuvée, Champagne, France

Aromas of white flowers, almond and elegant spice open up to layered flavours of white fruits, citrus, toasted brioche and marzipan. The fine, lingering bubbles and creamy mousse, crisp acidity and lengthy mineral finish are a classic expression of Krug luxury.



Château Lynch-Bages, Pauillac, Bordeaux, France, 2009

“Here comes the sun...” was the theme given by the vineyard for this rich, ripe, opulent vintage. Aromas of blackcurrant, blackberry pie and baked plums with chocolate box lead to a palate of the same black fruits with a grainy texture and a long finish.



Domaine Seguin Manuel, Clos des Mouches Beaune 1er Cru, Burgundy, France, 2023

Fine and elegant through and through, with summer fruits, a touch of rose petals and a delicate spiciness. Balanced and layered, it's underpinned by an intriguing minerality.

BUSINESS CLASS



Louis Roederer Collection 246, Champagne, France

Lively and delicate, with aromas of crisp green apple, candied citrus, peach and toasted brioche. It's balanced by a chalky salinity and soft, creamy bubbles, culminating in a graceful finish.



La Dame de Montrose, Saint Estephe, Bordeaux, France, 2017

A meeting of grace and vigour, born from a predominantly Merlot selection in the vineyards of Château Montrose. La Dame de Montrose 2017 is supple and inviting, offering a fresh, generous expression, marked by black fruit aromas, cedar notes and refined intensity.



Grant Burge Filsell Shiraz, Barossa Valley, South Australia, 2021

Warming aromas of red and dark cherries with subtle cinnamon and nutmeg lead to a palate that reveals layers of star anise, juniper, hazelnut liqueur, cherry and chocolate espresso, underpinned by dense tannins and a long finish.
